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Instructions to authors

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Length and language:

Articles must be submitted in English. French may be exceptionally authorized by the Editor-in-Chief, provided that an abridged English version (referring to the major illustrations and references) is associated with the French text. Maximum length: 10 printed pages in the journal, illustrations and reference list included (a page corresponds to 5 500 characters, spaces included; a one-column figure accounts for 1 375 signs, and a two-column one to 2 750 signs). Articles that do not meet the length requirements will be returned to the authors without review.

Commentary/Response or Perspective, is limited to 2 printed pages

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- title page: title (20 words maximum), full first name, family name and affiliation of each author; postal address, phone and fax number, e-mail address of the corresponding author;
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References must listed first in alphabetical order, and then chronologically, as follows: author alone, author with only one co-author, author with several co-authors, chronological order for references quoting the same authors. The list must include all references quoted in the text as well as in the figure and table captions.
